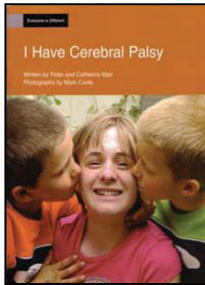

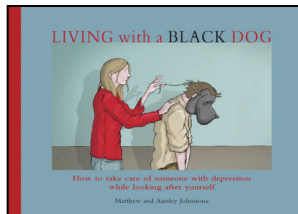

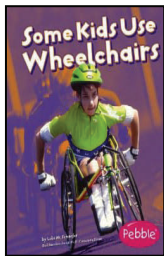
Katie was born with cerebral palsy and she tells us what it is like to live with cerebral palsy.

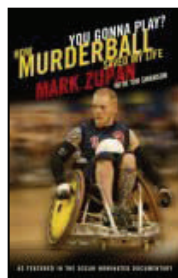
SOME KIDS USE WHEELCHAIRS

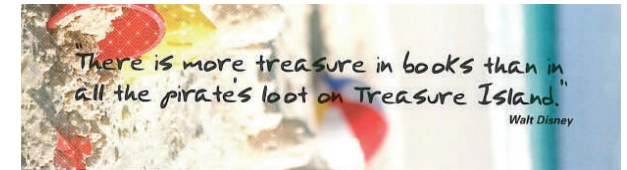

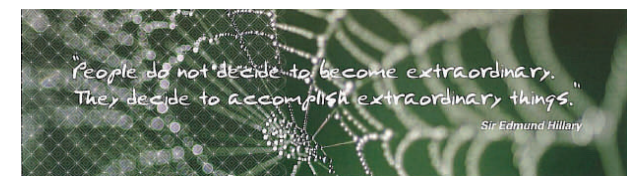


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Enable New Zealand offers a free disability library service specialising in DVD's and books.

YOUNG PEOPLE WITH DIABETES



In this DVD young people living with Type 1 diabetes, and their parents, offer candid accounts of their experiences surrounding diagnosis, management, lifestyle changes, hypos, school and their thoughts on the future.

CYSTIC FIBROSIS: Newly Diagnosed.

Cystic Fibrosis is a disorder of the exocrine glands that predominantly affects respiratory and digestive organs. This DVD features first hand accounts from parents, grandparents, children with cystic fibrosis and siblings about their experience of diagnosis and the impact CF has had on their lives.



ASTHMA IN CHILDHOOD



Asthma is the most common chronic illness in children and adolescents and the leading cause of childhood admissions to hospitals. In this dvd parents and young people offer their accounts of their experiences surrounding diagnosis, treatment, schooling, medication, self management and thoughts of the future.

MOTOR NEURONE DISEASE

This DVD offers first hand accounts from four people living with Motor Neurone Disease, their partners and parents. They discuss the issues at diagnosis and the impact MND has had on their lives.

LIVING WITH BOWEL CANCER

Colorectal, or bowel cancer is a malignant tumour in the colon or rectum and usually occurs in the middle or later life. Treatment is normally by surgical removal if the affected part of the colon or rectum. This may result in a person needing a colostomy, an opening of the bowel onto the outside of the body, which connects to a bag for collection of the body's waste.



THE MANY FACES OF EPILEPSY

Epilepsy is the world's most common serious brain disorder. It involves recurring seizures and can affect anyone at any time. This DVD offers first hand accounts from people affected by epilepsy. Issues covered include diagnosis, relationships, employment, medication and thoughts about the future.



OBSESSIVE COMPLUSIVE DISORDER

The purpose of this DVD is to provide a better understanding of OCD from the perspective of six people who lare affected by the disorder.. They discuss their experiences and the effect OCD has had on their lives.
