

# Indicators

## Vehicle Purchase & Modifications Level 2 Credential

Occupational Therapists assessing at this level may assess people who may require:

1. Pedal modifications such as a left foot accelerator to drive a vehicle safely; and/or
2. Modification to secondary controls including switches, knobs, levers, indicators, park brake and ignition to drive a vehicle safely and/or
3. Hand controls; and/or
4. A cognitive function assessment to determine safety to drive; or
5. An on road assessment to determine safety to drive

Option module (Drive from wheelchair or joystick technology) allows Occupational Therapists assessing at this level to assess people who may require:

6. A ramp hoist or other vehicle adaptation in order to access the vehicle while seated in a wheelchair for the purposes of driving whilst seated in a wheelchair; or
7. A wheelchair docking system to achieve safe driving from the wheelchair; or
8. A swing away back support for the purposes of driving from the wheelchair, or
9. Custom lateral supports to achieve safe driving from the wheelchair or
10. Joystick technology to achieve safe driving.
